We are currently re-organising the internal structure of some members of our family of companies and I would like you to be aware of what is happening.

The 'parent' company will, in future, be known as

THE SAMUELSON GROUP OF COMPANIES PLC

My three brothers and I are the directors, the letters PLC are the new designation for a Public Limited Company.

Our equipment rental activities will, from April this year, be handled by a separated company which will take the well-known and respected name, Samuelson Film Service Ltd. but probably with the word 'LONDON' inserted to clarify its location and area of operation. The company will have a new Board consisting of seven directors. In alphabetical order they are:

Guy Green, Karl Kelly, Barry Measure, Philip Measure,
John Rendall, Michael Samuelson and Bill Woodhouse

Messrs. Green, Kelly, Measure (B) and Woodhouse will be responsible for the efficient direction and running of the technical side of the company. Mr. Measure (P) will look after everything to do with financial viability and customer credit control. John Rendall will be the senior management link between the company and the users of its equipment and services and, as such, will have overall responsibility for the running of the Main Desk. Michael Samuelson, as a member of both boards, will be the liaison between Samuelson Film Service Ltd. and its parent company.

A completely new company is to be formed - SAMCINE PRODUCTS Ltd. is its provisional title - to design and handle the manufacture and/or modification of the many specialised items of equipment required by our rental company and by other members of our Group. It will supply equipment to Samuelson companies, not only in the U.K. but also in Australia, France and South Africa. All products made will be costed at the time of manufacture and supplied to the other companies at appropriate cost.

SAMCINE PRODUCTS Ltd. will also handle the highly specialised equipment and services we currently have available for rental to clients including FRONT PROJECTION and LOUMA.

In charge of this company will be my brother David and, as he will be serving as a director on both boards, he will provide the liaison between it and the Samuelson Group.



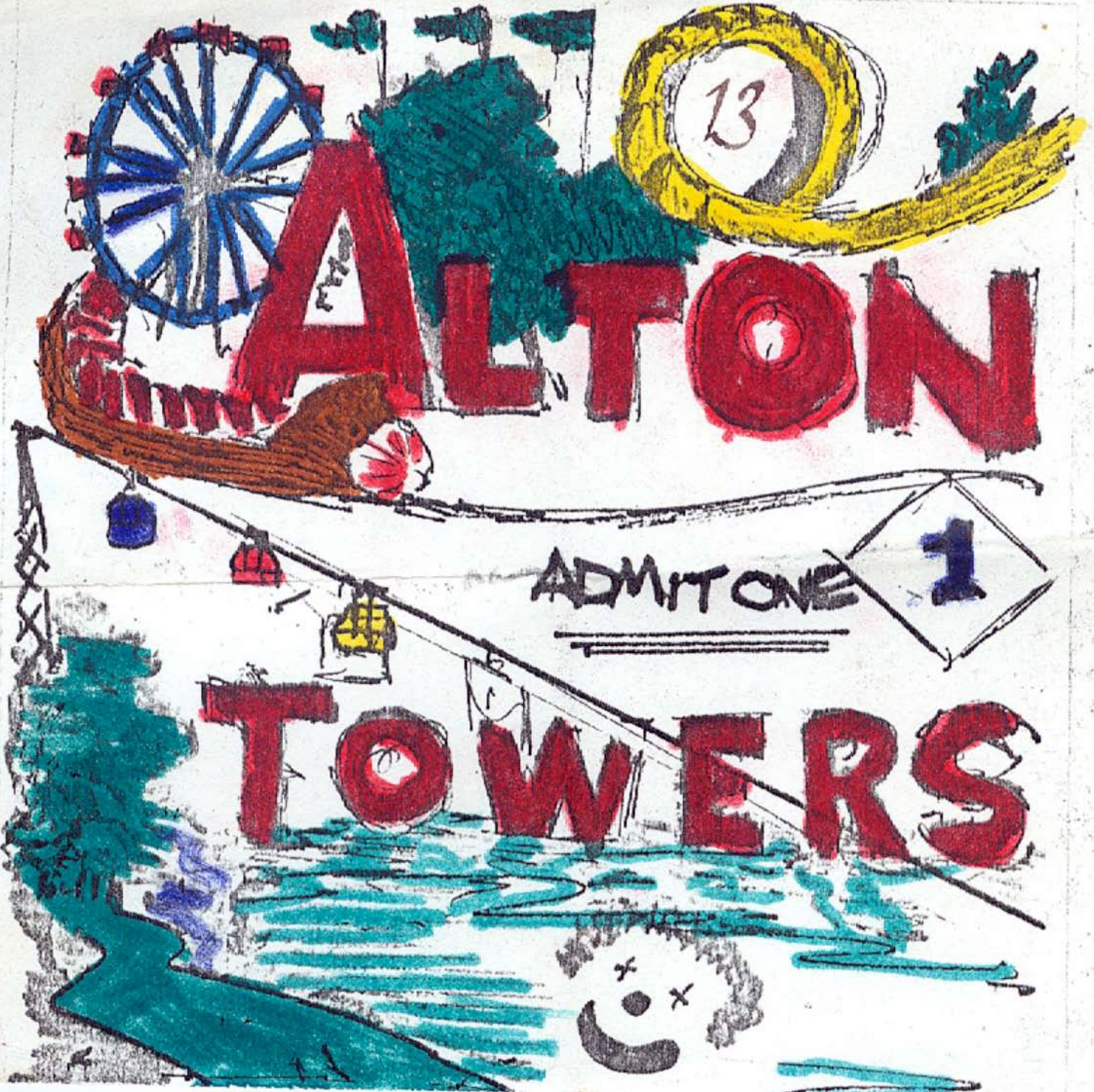


